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The World Health Organization observes 17th September as World Patient Safety Day. The theme for World Patient Safety Day 2022 is "Medication Safety". The theme builds on the ongoing WHO Global Patient Safety Challenge: "Medication Without Harm". Unsafe medication practices and medication errors are leading causes of avoidable harm in healthcare across the world. Medication errors occur when weak medication systems and human factors, such as fatigue, poor environmental conditions, or staff shortages affect prescribing, transcribing, dispensing, administration, and monitoring practices. This can result in severe patient harm, disability, and even death. Elderly patients (≥60 years of age) are susceptible to medication-related harm because of various factors. Improving the quality of medication use and medication safety are important priorities for prescribers who care for elderly patients. To observe the World Patient Safety Day 2022, ICMR-Centre for Ageing and Mental Health, Kolkata in association with the Indian Pharmacological Society (WB Chapter) will conduct a One-day Symposium on Medication Safety in Elderly Patients on 23 September 2022 at ICMR-Centre for Ageing and Mental Health, Kolkata.
