ICMR-AU Course (No.3/NIE/Dec, 2019) on 'Epidemiologic data analysis and Inference)' organized at ICMR- National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai during 2nd to 6th Dec, 2019

Under the ICMR/AU - STRC Health Practitioners/Researchers Capacity Building Scheme, a Call for Applications was announced (in June, 2019) for training of African researchers through <u>seven courses</u> to be conducted by the ICMR Institutes in India in the year 2019.

The sixth course on '**Epidemiologic data analysis and inference**' has been organized at ICMR- National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai during 2-6 December, 2019 and attended by 21 African researchers from Sierra Leone, Kenya, Egypt, Benin, Zambia, Morocco, Burundi, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Gambia, Gabon, Togo, Cameroon, Ghana and Tanzania.

This five-day course provides a comprehensive overview of epidemiological study designs, descriptive and analytical epidemiological analysis, data analysis using statistical software, and making valid inferences from data. The course is a combination of lectures, interactive case studies and hands-on training in using software for data analysis facilitated by experienced faculty from ICMR-National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai.
