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Specifications for Kisspeptin-10 and Neuropeptide Y ELISA Kits:

Indent no. 9628 (Department of Child Health Research)

Kisspeptin-10 and Neuropeptide Y : 1 kit each

- 1. ELISA kits should be based on the principle of Competitive enzyme immunoassay
- 2. ELISA kits should have species reactivity to humans only.
- 3. ELISA kits should have test size 96 wells
- 4. ELISA kits should have a minimum range of 0 -100 ng/ml
- 5. ELISA kits should have a minimum detection range as follows:
 - Kisspeptin-10 - 0.06 ng/ml Neuropeptide Y - 0.10 ng/ml
- 6. ELISA kits should have linear range as follows: Kisspeptin-10
 - 0.06 to 1.01 ng/ml
 - Neuropeptide Y 0.10 to 1.31 ng/ml
- 7. Intra-assay variation should be <10 %
- 8. Inter-assay variation should be <15 %
- 9. Kits should be applicable for both plasma and serum samples
- 10. Kits should have long expiry of atleast 6 months from the date of dispatch
- 11. Evidence of usage of both kits as cited from literature reference is mandatory.

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General Terms & Conditions

1. Tenders (Two Bids – Technical Bid and Commercial Bid in separate envelops to be sent together in a single big envelop) should reach ICMR-National Institute for Research in Reproductive and Child Health, Jahangir Merwanji Street, Parel, Mumbai 400012, Maharashtra before the prescribed date and time mentioned in the Tender. The tender not submitted as per the above prescribed manner will be treated as invalid.

2. All outstation tenders should be sent to so as to reach before the prescribed time limit. Late/delayed Tenders shall not be considered under any circumstances.

3. Tender should be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit [EMD] for an amount of Rs. 2,000 (Rupees Two Thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of The Director, ICMR - NIRRCH, payable at Mumbai and an undertaking wherein it may be stated that 'If they withdraw or modify their bid/s during period of validity etc. they will be suspended as per the directions of competent authority of the Institute'. The offer without EMD would be summarily rejected.

4. The Quantity of the kits may be increased at the discretion of ICMR – NIRRCH.

5. The expiry date of the kits should be at least one year from the date of final acceptance of the kits.

6. The last date for receipt of tenders in ICMR-NIRRCH is 20th April, 2023 up to 17.00 hrs. The offers received would be tentatively verified on 21st April, 2023 at 11.00 hrs.

7. The successful tenderers will have to submit Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee in favour of The Director, ICMR -NIRRCH, payable at Mumbai equivalent to 3% of the order value/contract cost (towards security of performance), which will be retained till the completion of warranty period, starting from date of successful installation and testing of Equipment. The Director reserves the right to exempt from said submission in case of low value orders.

8. The Director, NIRRCH, reserves the right to call for break-up of the quotation if it is found necessary. Incomplete specifications offered by the tenderer(s) will not be considered and are liable to be rejected.

9. The offers should be kept valid for acceptance for a period up to 30th July 2023.

10. The supply should be completed in 3 weeks from the date of receiving the confirmed order, unless specified otherwise. The supply, installation, testing and commissioning period should be clearly mentioned.

11. The payment will be arranged as per extant Government Rules and Regulations.

12. The prices quoted shall be firm for the duration of contract period. The tendered price should be quoted as the basic cost, without taxes and duties which may be indicated separately.

13. Conditional offers will not be accepted and liable to be rejected without any further reference.

14. In case of product offered is a Proprietary Product, Proprietary Article Certificate (as per Annexure 'PAC', as attached hereunder) may be provided by the OEM/Authorized Dealer / Stockiest of OEM) along with the offer.

15. Wherever tendered offer for an item is other than from manufacturer, such quotation must be accompanied by letter of commitment from the manufacturers and Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) executed duly between them on stamp paper that they would be supplying goods to the concerned trader/supplier in case supplier secured the order.

16. The bidders must provide complete circuit diagrams, wiring diagrams, component layout diagrams, Service/Maintenance manuals and component identification catalogue along with equipment free of charge in case order is placed to them.

17. The Director, ICMR-National Institute for Research in Reproductive and Child Health (NIRRCH), Mumbai reserves the rights to accept or reject any lowest tender in full or in part of any tender or all tenders without assigning any reasons and cancel the tender at any stage of the tender process.

18. Any of the disputes if arise between the Supplier/Tenderer and the NIRRCH/ICMR shall be resolved by the sole arbitrator which will be appointed by mutual consent of both the parties thereof failing which one of the Director of other Institute of ICMR in Mumbai (NIIH or NIV) shall be appointed within 30 days from the date of cause of action of dispute and the award as may be given by the sole arbitrator shall be binding on both the parties within the Civil Jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Bombay.
