Dear Secretary

As you may be aware, the Ministry of Home Affairs has launched the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) to strengthen the capabilities of Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) and to improve coordination among the LEAs and other agencies. The MHA has also launched the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) to facilitate online reporting of cyber crime incidents.

2. One of the key actions for preventing cyber crime is to generate sustained awareness among the public, especially among the vulnerable sections and groups on 'cyber hygiene'. The MHA had already requested to all Secretaries of the Ministries in Government of India, Chief Secretaries/Administrators and DGPs/CPs of all States/UTs to observe "Cyber Jaagrookta (Awareness) Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month in all the Schools/Colleges/Universities/Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), Municipalities, Ministries, PSUs, Government Undertakings, etc.

3. I request you to reiterate instructions to all the branches/sections/wings of the functionaries within your organization for celebrating "Cyber Jaagrookta Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month. It is further requested that as one year of CJD is getting completed in October, 2022, 06th October, 2022 (since, 05th October, 2022 i.e. Wednesday is Dussehra holiday) may be celebrated in an elaborative manner for propagating cyber hygiene, as mass awareness campaign, by involving dignitaries in various functions across all the States/UTs.

4. Budgetary provisions to carry out the CJD may be met from the respective budgets of the Ministry concerned. This initiative may be supplemented by mass awareness program through multiple media like television, community radio, radio jingles, SMS, etc.

5. Further, States/UTs are also requested to follow social media handles of I4C, MHA, the details of which are enclosed herewith for receiving regular cyber safety tips.

6. I would be grateful if the action taken note along with Annual Action Plan for celebrating Cyber Jaagrookta Diwas for the year 2022-23, along with details of activities undertaken on 06th October, 2022 for celebrating Cyber Jaagrookta Diwas (CJD) may be sent to MHA by 14th October, 2022.
