Located at Hailey Road, a central area in New Delhi, adjacent to the West Bengal Bhavan, our guest residents are primarily international scientists, researchers, public health professionals, visiting ICMR and/or its Institutes/Centres.

Dr. A.D. Engineer was Professor & Head of the Gynaecology Department, between 1953-76, at the King George's Medical College, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, India. She was a globally renowed Obstetrician & Gynaecologist at her times. She donated this apartment measuring area of 1500+660 sq. ft, at this upscale locality, in the capital city of India. Her vision was to improve and share the knowledge across the world, on Medicine, Health Science and in particular Gynaecology.
