Dear Secretary

As you are aware, close coordination between Government of India and States/UTs is of paramount importance for successful implementation of Government programmes, infrastructure projects and other developmental initiatives. In this regard, timely resolution of issues that may impede the progress is critical.

2. To facilitate quick resolution of such matters, a special module was created on e-Samiksha portal in 2014. The then Cabinet Secretary had written to you in this regard (copy of letter enclosed). The e-Samiksha online module is available for Central Ministries/Departments and State Governments to upload fresh issues and update the status of existing ones enabling real time monitoring. The designated nodal officers in each Ministry/Department and State Government are expected to regularly update the entries relevant to them, and in any case by the 5th of every month. The progress of implementation is regularly reviewed by this office. It is observed, however, that the Ministries/Departments are not utilizing this mechanism effectively.

3. It may be ensured that issues hampering implementation of important projects/ programmes are identified and taken up with respective States/UTs for resolution through the e-Samiksha portal. It would be desirable to take up only major issues such as pending clearances, land acquisition matters etc. and not routine matters. Similarly matters raised by States/UTs may also be addressed on priority. An appropriate mechanism may also be put in place to regularly review the progress. This would also be monitored by this office and reviewed in coordination meetings with Ministries/Departments and State Governments.

4. I request you to kindly give personal attention to this matter so that issues impeding progress of important programmes and projects are addressed in a timely manner.
