

The details of the Awards and form for making nominations for the Awards are enclosed.

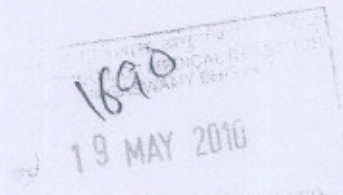

NATIONAL ACADEMY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES (INDIA)

AWARDS

1. **DR. S. S. MISRA MEMORIAL AWARD** : It was established in 1974 to perpetuate the memory of late Dr. S. S. Misra, a founder Fellow of the Academy. The award is in the form of a bronze Medal and cash prize out of income from endowment, for the best unpublished work in any field of Bio-Medical research by a biomedical scientist below the age of 40 years.
2. **DR. R. M. KASLIWAL AWARD**: This was founded by Dr. R. M. Kasliwal, FAMS and is awarded to the best worker in the area of Colon and its Diseases. The candidate is required to submit in addition to details about his work a complete bibliography on the subject including work done in India. There is no age restriction.
3. **DR. VIMLA VIRMANI AWARD**: This was founded by Dr. Vimla Virmani, FAMS. The award is in the form of a bronze medal and cash prize which is awarded for outstanding work in the field of physical and/or Psychosociological Rehabilitation of Neurologically and/or mentally afflicted subjects based on published or unpublished work with particular emphasis on the applicability of the work, under socio-cultural and economic conditions prevalent in the Indian Community.
4. **SHYAM LAL SAKSENA MEMORIAL AWARD**: This award has been established by the family of late Shri Shyam Lal Saksena to perpetuate his memory. The award is in the form of a bronze medal and cash prize out of the income from endowment for the best unpublished/published work in the field of Bio-medical Engineering by bio-medical scientists.
5. **SIR SHRIRAM MEMORIAL AWARD**: This was established in 1971 by the Shriram Foundation, and is in the form of a bronze medal and cash prize, out of income from endowment, to a bio-medical scientist for the best **published** work on Community Medicine (Community Health), Medical Education and Hospital Administration done in India, during the preceding three years. In case of joint authorship, scrutiny will only be done if the nominee is the first author. There is no age restriction.
6. **DENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH AWARD** : This Award has been established by the Indian Association of Public Health Dentistry with the aim of recognizing merit and encouraging talent in Public Health Dentistry. The award is given for distinguished work carried out by the nominee during the preceding 3 years and published in a peer reviewed national or international journal, specifically related to Public Health Dentistry.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Academy awards Orations to eminent Indian Biomedical Scientists for their outstanding contributions in the field of medical and related sciences every year. The details about various Orations are enclosed herewith.

A candidate is eligible for nomination for a maximum of two Orations related to professional experience/research.

As per Council decision, the nominations received for Orations will be considered for three consecutive years. In view of this, the candidates who had been nominated in 2008 and 2009 need not send their fresh nominations.

The Council in its meeting held on 12th July, 2008 made the following observations:-

"A Bio-medical Scientist who has been awarded an Oration in recognition of the work carried out by him/her should not be considered for the Award of any other Oration within 10 years from the date he/she has delivered the previous Oration. Furthermore, if he/she is considered for the award of a second Oration, the topic of the Oration should be entirely in a different area of expertise and specialization other than the one under which he/she was previously recommended for the Oration".

A candidate who has been nominated for a particular Oration should not propose the name of any other candidate for the same Oration.

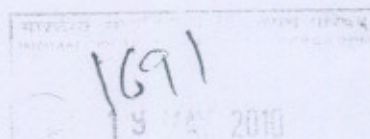
The Orations carry a cash award and a commemorative medal.

To commemorate the outstanding contributions to clinical neurosciences of Dr.Baldev Singh who was Founder Fellow of the Academy, and Foundation Professor of Neurology, All-India Institute of Medical Sciences, the National Academy of Medical Sciences has instituted an Annual Oration out of the funds graciously donated in 2007 by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab, to be named 'Dr.Baldev Singh Oration'.

Orator must have made original contributions to the practice of neurology or any of its branches, and including amongst others, clinical or laboratory diagnosis, medical or surgical management, and/or prevention of neurological disorders at the individual or community level. The selected Orator will be a recognized leader in the practice of one or more of the subspecialities of neurology with a record of scientific publications in national/international journals of high impact factor, or shall have achieved professional excellence through his/her clinical research with a demonstrable impact on the health outcome(s) of neurological disorders.

The Oration shall be delivered, in alternate years, at the Annual Meeting of the National Academy of Medical Sciences, and at the Government Medical College, Amritsar. The first Baldev Singh oration will be delivered during the 50th Annual Conference of NAMS.
