
Sub: DPC Guidelines – No supersession in promotions - regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 25th August 2008 followed by reminders of even number dated 6.10.2008, 15.10.2008 and 21.10.2008 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the status report as desired in DoP&T's O.M. dated 16.2.2005 and 15.9.2005 on the amendment of the RRs/Service Rules in conformity with the provision of DoP&T's O.M. dated 8.2.2002 has not been received from a number of Ministries/Departments so far.

2. The Committee on Sub-ordinate Legislation(14th Lok Sabha) of the Department of Personnel & Training in its para 1.4 relating to non-observance of DoP&T's guidelines on framing of Recruitment Rules in accordance with the provisions of DoP&T's O.M. dated 8.2.2002 has sought a status report thereon. Accordingly, all Ministries/Departments were requested to submit the same by 5.9.21008 positively as per this Department's O.M. dated 25.10.2008. The same has not been received from a number of Ministries/Departments till date despite reminders of even number dated 6.10.2008, 15.10.2008 and 21.10.2008.

3. Since status of the Action Taken Report has to be furnished to the Lok Sabha Sectt., it is once again requested that the status report highlighting the action taken by the Ministry/Department in this regard may be furnished to this Department immediately and in no case beyond 15th September 2010, positively. In case no report is received in this Department by this date, it would be presumed that necessary amendments have been carried out in the RRs/Service Rules in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's O.M. dated 8.2.2002 and nothing is pending. The responsibility for not amending the RR by this date would squarely lie on the Ministry/Department concerned.
