

Subject: Nomination for Prince Mahidol Award 2010.

The Deputy Chief of Mission and DPR to UNESCAP, Embassy of India, Bangkok, Thailand has informed that the Thai Foreign office has approached them to seek nomination of individuals/organizations for being considered for the prestigious Prince Mahidol Award 2010. A copy of the communication received from the Embassy of India, Bangkok, Thailand in this regard is enclosed.

There are two categories for the Award:

- (i) Medicine - for outstanding performance and/or research ; and
- (ii) Public Health - for outstanding contribution for the well being of the people.

The prize money in each category is US \$ 50,000 and the last date for submission of application is 31 May 2010.

An individual or group of individuals or an institution may be nominated by national medical or health authorities or by individual or group of individuals in nongovernmental capacity, as candidates for the Award. Nominations are transmitted to the secretary-general of the Prince Mahidol Award Foundation.

The nomination forms, which can be submitted either online or by mail, are forwarded to the panel of Scientific Advisory Committee for initial screening. The nomination forms, which have been screened by Scientific Advisors, are then forwarded to the International Award Committee, which comprises several world-renowned experts in the fields of medicine and public health, who will consider them and make recommendations to the Foundation's Board of Trustees. The Foundation's Board of Trustees makes final approval.

Nomination forms may be submitted either on online by **31 May 2010** or sent to this Division latest by **21 May 2010** for onward transmission to Embassy of India, Bangkok, Thailand.

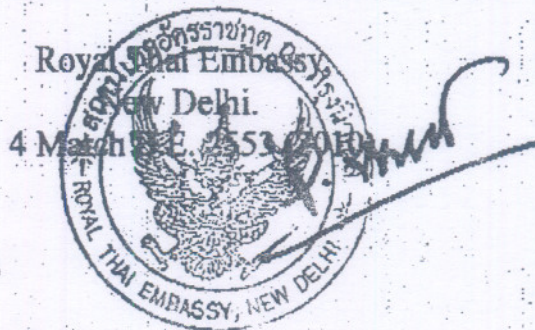

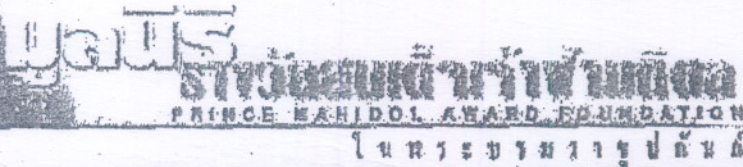
