The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the question of extending the facility of providing health care in Army and Cantonment Hospitals on payment basis to all AIS officers and their families while serving in the North-East Region, has been engaging the attention of the Government for some time. Accordingly, Ministry of Defence has issued necessary instruction to all Military Hospital in the NE region to provide medical care to All India Service officers and their families as non entitled civil gazetted officers and charge, hospital stoppage rates (HSR). A copy of the Ministry of Defence' letter No. 9(1)194/D (Mel), dated the 11th August, 2009 issued in this regard is forwarded along with enclosures for information and necessary action.

Note 1 Hospital stoppages will be recovered by Armed Forces hospitals direct from government servants, who in turn, will claim reimbursement from the Government, as admissible under CS (MA) Rules

Note 2: The rates will be halved in case of children under twelve years of age

Note 3: In case of wives and other dependent members of the family the rates of hospital stoppages will be based on the ward to which admitted

Note 4: Same as note 1 of para 53 C of Appendix V of RMSAF. Same as note 6 below

Note 5: Non entitled civilians who are not Govt servants when admitted to the Armed forces hospitals will be accommodated as shown in this chart:

Note 6: Civilian beneficiaries among the non entitled cases when admitted for the purposes of tubectomy, vasectomy, IUD insertion and post operative complications will not be asked to make payments for the hospital stoppages during their stay in the hospital

Note 7: The hospital stoppages recovered under this para will cover for the accommodation, routine investigations and routine procedures, including the diet. This includes the services of specialist on the advice of the MO i/c provided the specialist resides in the station and no and extra expenditure to the state is involved in calling her/him/them. However, the charges for laboratory investigations, other than routine, X - Ray examination, ECG examination and other special investigations and procedures will be charged extra in addition to the hospital stoppages as per the rates prescribed for non entitled patients.
