Organization of Training/Workshop:

PARTICIPANT'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE CONFERENCE /TRAINING / WORKSHOP:

The poster entitled "Effect of Hyperglycaemia on the Expression of Aquaporins in Diabetic Rat Testis" was presented by me (Mr. Arun. K, Research Fellow, Department of Biochemistry, Bharathidasan University) at the EASD 50th Annual Meeting, Reed Messe Vienna, Congress Center Messeplatz1, A-1021Vienna, Austria. September 15th-19th, 2014.

The poster revealed expression of AQPs 7, 8, 9, & 11 in the testis of diabetic rats were altered compared to controls. Alteration of AQPs expression leads to disruption of water homeostasis and affects spermatogenesis. Furthermore, altered expression and regulation of AQPs have already been demonstrated to be the cause of several disorders of the male reproductive system. The full enlightenment of these molecular interactions and mechanisms may point towards possible therapeutic targets to counteract diabetes induced male subfertility/infertility. This study elicited an interest among diabetologists to understand the importance of diabetes in infertility. There were many valuable suggestions and comments regarding the role of aquaporins in infertility. It proved to be a thought provoking interactive discussion. This EASD 50th annual meeting travel definitely helped in enhancing my scientific career as a researcher.
