2. All posts are purely temporary and contractual for the duration offered in the adhoc project. The appointment may be renewed after every specific period of time subject to satisfactory performance and project requirement.
3. Appointment can be terminated at any time during the engagement from either side with notice period of one month.
4. Incomplete applications, application not submitted in prescribed format and application without supportive documents asked for shall be summarily rejected.
5. Qualification and experience should be in relevant discipline/field and from a reputed Institution / organization recognized by relevant authority.
6. Experience shall be counted from the date of completion of minimum essential educational qualification.
7. Submission of incorrect or false information at any stage of recruitment shall disqualify the candidature at any stage.
8. **The Director reserves the right to increase / decrease the number of vacancies as per requirement.**
