- 2) In case number of applications will be high, only shortlisted candidates will be called for Walk-in Interview.
- 3) The shortlisted candidates will be informed regarding interview at NIMR, Delhi via email.
- 4) Candidates have to submit the duly self attested copies of proof of their age, educational qualifications, experiences, testimonials etc. at the time of joining, if selected.
- 5) Selected candidates have to bring all the documents as mentioned above in Original while joining.

## **NOTE:** Shortlisted candidates will be informed about interview through e-mail.

#### Other terms and conditions for applications are given here under:

- 1) Incomplete applications or not submitted in prescribed format or without photo and signature or received after last date shall be summarily rejected.
- 2) Submission of incorrect or false information shall disqualify the candidature at any stage

- 4) Age limit and experience will be considered as on the date of receipt of Application Form.
- 5) The Director, NIMR has the right to accept/ reject any application without assigning any reason thereof and no correspondence will be entertained in this matter.
- 6) The Director, NIMR reserves the right to increase / decrease the number of vacancies as per requirement.
- 7) The Director, NIMR reserves right to fill up or not fill up any of the post advertised on website.
- 8) Canvassing and bringing outside influence in any form for short listing or employment will be treated as disqualification and the candidate will be debarred from selection process
