2	Qualification	12 th Pass in Science subjects and (two-year diploma in Medical Laboratory Technician or PMW or radiology/radiography) or (one year DMLT plus one year required experience in a recognized organization) or (two years’ field/laboratory experience* in Government recognized organization.) *B.Sc. degree shall be treated as 3 years’ experience.
3	Maximum age limit	30 years
4.	Emoluments	18,000/- consolidated p.m.
5	Duration	Three years or completion of project, whichever is earlier. Initial appointment will be for a period of six months, extendable upon the satisfactory performance of the candidate
6	Job requirement	To carry out field study, laboratory work and other project related work like PFT.
7	Desirable/Preference	Preference will be given to candidates having work experience in projects sponsored by ICMR or similar government organizations.

2	Qualification	Intermediate or 12 th pass from recognized board. A speed of not less than 8000 key depression per hour on computer. [Note: Candidates are instructed to bring certificate for the Computer typing not less than 8000 key depression per hour.]
3	Maximum age limit	25 years
4.	Emoluments	17,000/- consolidated p.m.
5	Duration	Three years or completion of project, whichever is earlier. Initial appointment will be for a period of six months, extendable upon the satisfactory performance of the candidate
6	Job requirement	To carry out data entry and to help in data analysis, field work and other project related work
7	Desirable/Preference	Preference will be given to candidates having work experience of more than 2 years in projects sponsored by ICMR or similar government organizations.

Terms & Conditions

1. The original certificates may be produce for verification on demand. The application duly signed by the applicant should be submitted along with self-attested copies of the certificates. (a) Proof of Date of Birth (b) Qualification (c) Experience (d) Recent Passport size photograph. Unsigned/ incomplete applications or applications without supportive evidence shall be summarily rejected. Candidates applying for more than one post should provide separate applications for each of the posts applied. **Only shortlisted candidates will be allowed for written test/Interview after verification of documents.**
2. Qualification & experience required are as per ICMR guidelines; experience shall be counted after acquiring the essential qualification; age limit and experience will be considered as on date of walk-in written test / interview.
3. Benefits of Provident Fund, CCA, Leave Travel Concession, Medical Claim, Leave Concession etc. are not admissible. The posts are purely temporary, co-terminate with the project, and the incumbents selected will have no claim for regular appointment/employment under ICMR-NIOH/ROHC(S)/ICMR or continuation in other project and his/her engagement will be deemed terminated immediately after expiry of the project
4. Age relaxation will be given to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category as per Govt. of India rules. Age concession to the extent of service rendered in other research projects will also be admissible for experienced and skilled persons.
5. Candidates employed in Govt. Service /Semi Govt. /Autonomous Bodies of State/Central Govt. should submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their employer at the time of walk-in written test / Interview.
6. As per ICMR guidelines selection of candidates shall be made by walk-in written test /Interview. If required, the written examination/test shall be of one (1) hour duration consisting of objective type questions on General Science, General Analytical Ability and knowledge of concerned area.
