: I learned both theoretical and technical aspects of the roles of neurotransmitter receptors, cytokines, neurotrophins, cellular signaling, neural plasticity, and gene regulation in depression and suicide risk through gene expression, RNA sequencing, microRNAs, and epigenetic approaches. I have also observed various approaches of research in suicide such as human postmortem brain studies, peripheral blood cell studies from patient population, rat brain studies involving manipulation of the stress axis, rodent models of depression and post-traumatic disorder, and gene knockout mice.
