✓ On the occasion of the World Environment Day, this year, i.e. June 5, 2024, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched a Global Campaign #एक_पेड़_मां_के_नाम #Plant4Mother. The Hon'ble Prime Minister exhorted people to plant trees as a mark of love and respect for one's own Mother, and for protecting and preserving Mother Earth.

2. As part of the #एक_पेड़_मां_के_नाम# Plant4Mother campaign, efforts are being made to ensure that about 80 crore saplings are planted across the country by September, 2024 and about 140 crore saplings by March, 2025. The Campaign has immense potential for preventing and reversing land degradation and desertification.






The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's Office Memorandum No. 28/03/2024-P&PW(B)/Gratuity/9559 dated 30.05.2024 wherein the maximum limit of retirement Gratuity and Death Gratuity under the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2021 or the Central Civil Services (Payment of Gratuity under National Pension System) Rules, 2021, was increased by 25% i.e., from Rs. 20.00 Lakh to Rs. 25.00 Lakh, with effect from 1st January, 2024.

2. This Department has been receiving reference from various quarters that their Ministry/Department has not revised their gratuity limit despite orders of this Department. Further, it has been revealed by the Bhavishya Portal that 5012 cases are pending for want of gratuity revision by different Ministries/Departments reflecting unsatisfactory progress in the matter.

3. In view of the above, it is requested that implementation of this Department's orders dated 30.05.2024 may be ensured and all orders for payment of gratuity should be processed as per above order only.



Sir/Madam,

Government of India has approved the National Action for Mechanized Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE) scheme, a Central Sector Scheme for welfare of Sewer and Septic Tank Workers (SSWs) and having the components of erstwhile 'Self Employment for Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (MS). Standing Finance Committee (SFC) in its meeting held on 20.06.2024 has approved for inclusion of Waste Pickers as third component in the NAMASTE scheme from the F.Y. 2024-25. Accordingly, guidelines for implementation of the scheme for welfare of wastepickers is attached.

2. It is therefore requested that wide publicity may be given to the Scheme Guidelines for inclusion of waste-pickers in NAMASTE scheme and issue necessary instructions to the concerned implementing agencies for prompt implementation of the scheme.
