- Nominations can be submitted by Heads of Departments/ District Collectors/ Central and State Governments under the innovation category
- Awards shall be given to Organizations of Central Government, State Governments and Districts
- Whatsapp groups will be formed to facilitate better understanding of the award schemes and address any issues faced during registration and application submission
- Communication updates related to the awards process will be displayed on the portal under the head of communication
- The awards to be given out in 2019 will also be given this year



### Important points to Note

- If DC/DM/organization has applied last year, they can apply again this year provided the scheme criteria is met
- Period of consideration for these awards is from 1<sup>St</sup> April 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020
- Hold regular meetings with departments/districts and sensitize them on the revamped category for Innovation (General) in PM Awards 2020
- Encourage maximum participation by the departments/districts in Innovation(General) category
- Request your feedback on the feasibility of the spot study
- Request everyone to share their views
