8th-9th September 2016

States & Organisations offering best governance practices in an ecologically and socio-culturally sustainable way are requested to send their nominations. The organisations should demonstrate innovation in its governance practices adequately responding to local conditions. The governance model should be conducive for effective decision-making, problem solving, disputes and conflict management, and actively produce measurable results in addressing key felt-needs and challenges. The organisation's governance practices should also have the ability to adapt to future challenges and changing circumstances.

Terms & Conditions

- Nomination must reach by 17:00 hrs, IST on 24th July 2016
- Nominations received by 7th July will get 10 percent additional points*
- Nominations received by 15th July will get 5 percent additional points*
- Each submission must include: A completed nomination form / Project Information as per the enclosed format.
- Both hard and electronic copies (submitted via website) are needed. The hard copies should be duly signed and stamped.
- States from large number of nominations received may be considered for conducting of evaluation roundtable at state level.

- The certificates and awards are conferred in person only and all qualifying nominees would need to personally attend 45th Skoch Summit on 8th - 9th September 2016.
- No Delegate fee for one awardee, for everyone else a delegate fee of INR 10,000 per delegate or INR 40,000 for five delegates would apply for attending the two day conference.

Skoch Smart Governance Awards 2016 methodology is as follows:

1. Selected Projects will be called for evaluation presentation in August 2016 or later in New Delhi.
2. A merit list of Top National Projects will be released by 31st August 2016.
3. Merit listed projects will be showcased and will receive Skoch Order-of-Merit awards on 8th September 2016.
4. Finalists will be chosen from among the merit listed projects. Skoch Smart Governance Awards to be conferred on 9th September 2016.
5. Attendance during the evaluation presentation and 45th Skoch Summit is mandatory to qualify for the Award.

As a part of the process, an Awards Committee is constituted, which comprises of senior professionals from academia, government, industry and other stakeholders in the area of governance. Initial screening of the project is carried out on the basis of the information sought in the prescribed format. Additional information, if required, would be sought and may be supplemented with Skoch's own research or the knowledge base of the Awards Committee. Public voting is solicited for wider stakeholder consultation and gets a weightage determined by the Awards Committee depending on the nature of the project. The Awards Committee then deliberates and decides on the awardees. The Committee may also nominate projects in special category that it feels should be in the consideration set.

Ethics Policy
