Respected Sir,

Keeping in view of the Government's policy to repeal the obsolete and redundant laws which have lost their significance, the Two Member Committee constituted by the PMO, the Law Commission of India and the Legislative Department have identified 1827 redundant and obsolete Central Acts for repeal.

2. After careful examination and consultation with various Ministries/Departments in the Government of India, the following four Acts have been enacted by Parliament--

They are:

- (i) The Repealing and Amending Act, 2015 (17 of 2015) repealing 35 Acts;
- (ii) The Repealing and Amending (Second) Act, 2015 (19 of 2015) repealing 90 Acts;
- (iii) The Appropriation Acts (Repeal) Act, 2016 (22 of 2016) repealing 756 Appropriation Acts including Appropriation (Railways) Acts; and
- (iv) The Repealing and Amending Act, 2016 (23 of 2016) repealing 294 Acts;

With the enactment of the aforesaid 4 Acts, so far 1175 Acts have been repealed (35+90+756+294).
