Government has started Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) with the aim to ensure accurate targeting of the beneficiaries, de-duplication and reduction of Most importantly, it is expected to re-engineer the existing delivery process of government schemes for simpler and faster flow of information and funds. The preferred route of flow of funds would involve transfer of defined benefits directly from the concerned Ministries to the bank account of the beneficiary by using the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) platform.

- For DBT in scholarships, National e-Scholarships Portal (NeSP) has been developed by Centre for Good Governance (CGG)/Department of Electronics & Information Technology (DeitY) as one stop solution through which all the scholarships of all Central Ministries/Departments will be processed electronically starting from student applicantion, application receipt, uploading of the documents, processing verification of documents and eligibility, sanction and disbursal including financial and administrative approvals. The whole end to end process is IT based automated and electronic.
- It is requested that the details of the scholarship schemes alongwith of beneficiaries and budget allocation, administered in the Ministry/Department may be intimated to the DBT Mission as per proforma B(EPM) 1 & PPY(A) enclosed.
