Dear Sh. Johar,

Delay in first credit of pension after retirement has been a major concern in the past and has been a major agenda in the high level forms. After a prolonged process of 4 years routed through different channels, DP&PW has decided to delink the physical identification of pension for crediting the first credit and to make the undertaking of recovery of excess payment a part of PPO vide OM No. 1/27/2011-P&PW (E) dated 7th May, 2014.

These decisions were conveyed to all concerned for complying with the same scrupulously vide CPAO's OM No. CPAO/Tech/Simplification/2014-15/52 dated-28.05.2014 followed by OM No. CPAO/Tech/Simplification/2014-15/241-351 dated-08.08.2014. These orders have been made available on CPAO's website www.cpaonnic.in also. But due to lack of required co-operation from Head of Offices, the instructions of these orders are not strictly complied with and CPAO is still receiving a number of PPOs without Undertaking for recovery of excess payment of pension, as a result the main reason of delay in first credit of pension by the banks still persists.

Being responsible for initiating and forwarding the pension cases alongwith necessary documents, the Head of Offices should be more vigilant in obtaining the undertaking of recovery of over payment from the retiring government servant alongwith other documents to be submitted to Pay & Accounts Office for authorization of pension. Taking into consideration the slackness of the Head of Office in attaching this undertaking alongwith pension cases and resulting status-quo of delay in first credit of pension, it is felt that your intervention in the matter may gear-up compliance of the above instructions and facilitate the root out main reason in delay of first credit of pension.

Accordingly, it is requested to issue necessary instructions to Head of Offices under your control to ensure timely submission of undertaking of recovery of over payment in the prescribed Proforma without fail.
