If has been observed that recently, an officer joined a new assignment without getting himself relieved from the previous post and without the approval of the competent authority for holding the additional charge of the post.

- FR 49 provides that only the Central Government may appoint a Government servant already holding a post in a substantive or officiating capacity to officiate, as a temporary measure, in one or more of other independent posts at one time under the Government.
- 3. It may, therefore, be noted that:
  - (i)An officer is required to get himself relieved from the previous post before he joins another post,
  - (ii)The officer should only be appointed to a new assignment or given an additional charge of the post only with the approval of the competent authority.
- The above is brought to the notice of all Ministries/Departments for strict compliance
